
WEEKS 8 & 9

Use some of the ideas we developed together in class and design a great chocolate package. You could make it 3D to be even more impressive.</p>

Write down as many words as you can make from the word CHOCOLATE.</p> 	<p>6. DRAW a scene from <i>Charlie and the Chocolate Factory</i>. Add a caption to your drawing to make it easy to tell from which part of the story the drawing comes.</p> 
<p>7. Write a LIST of the names of as many chocolate bars as you can think of, in alphabetical order.</p> 	<p>8. SURVEY 20 people to find out their favourite chocolate bar (give them 5 choices). Present the results as a graph. (See Mrs R for graph paper)</p> 	<p>9. RESEARCH to find out from where cacao beans come. Highlight these places on a world map. (See Mrs R for a blank map)</p>
